## 1) Central Govt. Schemes

### 1) Prime Minister National Relief Fund

Facts:

- P.M.N.R.F. is only for Govt. Hospital and Certain Listed hospital ([http://pmindia.nic.in/pmnrh\\_hospitals.php](http://pmindia.nic.in/pmnrh_hospitals.php))
- Any cancer patient can apply.
- One time Financial Assistance.
- Half Amount Sanctioned.
- No Reimbursement of medical expenditure already incurred.

Documents Required:

- Original Estimate Certificate
- Member of Parliament (MPs) recommendation letter addressed to the Prime Minister.
- Family permanent address proof (Voter Id/ ration card/ Aadhar card/ Driving License)
- Patient Photo (2 nos)
- Request letter from the family addressed to the Prime Minister

How to apply:

After Collecting all the relevant documents send it to Prime Minister's Office by Speed Post or Submit by hand at Prime Minister's Office, South Block, Raisina Hill, New Delhi 110001.

### 2) National illness assistance fund (RAN)

Facts:

- Only BPL Ration card holders can apply through RAN.
- Lower income households of APL Category can also apply.
- Full Amount Sanctioned
- No Reimbursement of medical expenditure already incurred.
- One time Financial Assistance.

### **3) Health Minister's Discretionary Grants (H.M.D.G.)**

Facts:

- BPL/APL cardholder's can apply through HMDG.
- Those having annual family income upto Rs. 1.0 lakh and below are eligible for financial assistance.
- Maximum limit of assistance Rs. One Lakh only.
- No Reimbursement of medical expenditure already incurred.
- One time Financial Assistance.

- BPL/APL Ration Card photocopy duly attested by Doctor/Gazetted officer.
- Original Income Certificate

Financial assistance given:

- Rs 50,000 - if the estimate cost of treatment is up to Rs. 1,00,000
- Rs 75,000 - if the estimated cost of treatment is above Rs. 1,00,000 & up to Rs 1,50,000
- Rs 1,00,000 - if the estimated cost of treatment is above Rs.1,50,000

### **4) Health Minister's Cancer Patient Fund (H.M.C.P.F.)**

Facts:

- Only BPL Ration card holders can apply through RAN
- Lower income households of APL Category can also apply.
- No Reimbursement of medical expenditure already incurred.
- Maximum amount sanction Rs. 1.0 lakh.

- 27 Regional Cancer Centers have been authorized from Central Government for treatment of Cancer Patients.
- One time Financial Assistance.

## **5) Dr. Ambedkar Medical Aid**

Facts:

- The applicant shall belong to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Community.
- Shall only be given for Surgery.
- Those having annual family income upto Rs. 1 lakh and below are eligible for financial assistance.
- Only 75 percent of total expenditure shall be disbursed subject to a ceiling of Rs One Lakh.
- 50 % paid before surgery and rest 50 % after surgery.
- One time Financial Assistance.

### Documents Required:

- Estimate Certificate Original
- BPL/APL Ration Card photocopy duly attested by Doctor/Gazetted officer.
- SC/ ST certificate
- Original Income Certificate
- OPD Card Photocopy
- The application shall be recommended and forwarded by the local sitting Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha or Rajya Sabha) or by the District Magistrate & Collector / Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District or the Secretary in-charge of Health & Social Welfare Departments of the State/UT.

### How to apply:

- After Collecting all the relevant documents, fill an application form.
- Application duly signed/stamped by the Medical Superintendent of Hospital.
- After completing all the process, application should be submitted to the

Director, Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, 15, Janpath, New Delhi, at least 15 days before the date of surgery.

Every State has its own CM fund, and has different requirements and requisites to apply

#### State Illness Assistance Fund

50% contribution by State Govt.

Maximum limit of Rs. 1.50 lakh per case afterwards cases are referred to RAN.

Same procedure to apply as of RAN.

### 3) Hospital Facilitation

Getting Charges waived off for diagnostics.

Getting free medicines and other equipments like SDP kits and catheters etc. from hospital.

Getting blood from Blood Bank

Getting early dates of tests and diagnostics whenever there is an emergency.

Coordination with Hospital doctors, Social worker and other staff to avail hospital facilities for Children with Cancer.

Coordination with other facilities available in hospital

## **ANDHRA PRADESH**

Andhra Government funding is a catch-all term that describes money given by government agencies to non-government organizations and individuals as a relief to the people suffered due to natural calamities various diseases, major accidents, riots, etc.

- a. Rajiv Arogyashri Health Insurance
- b. The Prime Minister’s National Relief Fund (PMNRF) was established with public contributions primarily to render immediate relief to families of those died in natural calamities and to the victims of the major accidents and riots. Assistance from PMNRF is also rendered for medical treatment like heart surgeries, kidney transplantaion, cancer treatment, etc
- c. The “Health Minister’s Cancer Patient Fund (HMCPF) within the Rashtriya Arogya Nidhi (RAN)” has been established in 27 Regional Cancer Centres (RCCs)
- d. The Chief Ministers Relief Fund (CMRF) is primarily utilized to render immediate relief to families of those affected by natural calamities, victims of the major accidents and riots. In addition to this, the CMRF provides financial assistance to indigent patients for treatment for major diseases at Government/CMRF empanelled hospitals.

Example - Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jan Arogya Yojana in Maharashtra state

Every State CMRF fund process is different

- e. The President Fund was established primarily to render immediate relief to families for medical treatment of cancer.
- f. Income less than 1 lakh
- g. Patient who is treated in Government Hospital or Regional Cancer Hospital
- h. Central Govt./State Govt. /PSU (Public Sector Undertaking) employees are not eligible for financial assistance
